PROJECT SUPPORT GRANTS, APPLICATION AND DEADLINES

GRANT AMOUNTS

General grantmaking awards are made twice a year for requests of up to \$5000. Awards are selected for projects and programs that best meet the grant criteria and reflect the mission of the CFFC.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

For consideration, qualified organizations are invited to submit a completed Grant Request Summary (which can be found on our website), along with a brief proposal (2-3 pages) and a concise budget. Additional information may be requested after review of proposals.

Please include the following information in your proposal:

- description and brief history of your organization
- project narrative and details
- project budget
- additional funders and support
- contact information
- organization's IRS determination letter with 501 (c) (3) status
- most recent audit
- listing of current staff and board members
- annual report, if available

HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Foundation offers a variety of higher education scholarship awards ranging from approximately \$200 - \$2000. These awards are available to graduating high school seniors and to students already enrolled in a college, university or business school. Awards cover a wide range of designations and criteria, but applicants must be Fayette County residents to apply.

To be considered for an award, applicants must complete and submit the Scholarship Application Form (found on our website), along with the following: (a) a copy of SAT or ACT scores, (b) a transcript stating cumulative GPA, and (c) the SAR (Student Aid Report) from the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

Students may apply any time after January 1 and before April 1 to be considered. Selection is based on a variety of factors including academic promise and financial need. However, some scholarship award funds do not require financial need as part of their criteria.

The Scholarship Committee makes award recommendations from the pool of applicants. Some scholarship fund awards are made directly through the high schools. Students are encouraged to visit their High School Guidance Offices to learn more about scholarship opportunities and the application process.

PENNSYLVANIA EDUCATIONAL IMPROVEMENT TAX CREDIT (EITC) TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM – DESIGNATED FOR GRADES K-12 AND PRE-KINDERGARTEN

The Foundation is an approved participant in Pennsylvania's Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) Scholarship (grades K-12) and Pre-kindergarten Scholarship Programs. The EITC Program provides companies with a 75-90% tax credit for donations to approved non-profit organizations. The scholarship organizations then offer tuition assistance to the families of children to attend private or parochial schools in Pennsylvania.

There are very specific income levels and a residency requirement. Qualifying Fayette County families with children attending private or parochial school may apply. To be considered, please complete the standardized EITC Scholarship Application Form (found on our website) and return with school transcript and income verification to the CFFC Office no later than July 1.

PENNSYLVANIA COUNCIL ON THE ARTS PARTNERS IN THE ARTS PROGRAM



The Community Foundation of Fayette County is a partner in the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts (PCA) Partners in the Arts Program. The Foundation is one of 16 partners from across the state that assists in this re-granting program, which allows state money to be

distributed on a local level to artists and organizations planning public arts projects. The goal is to make arts programs (including the visual arts, music, theatre and dance) available to every Pennsylvania resident. The Foundation administers awards in three counties – Washington, Greene and Fayette.

There are 2 types of funding – Program Stream and Project Stream.

Program Stream is a funding opportunity providing general operating support to arts organizations. Groups must be invited to apply to Program Stream, and

must show multiple years of successful Project Stream funding, with continued highly scored assessments on applications.

Project Stream provides annual awards of up to \$3000 to eligible organizations or individuals conducting projects in the arts. All projects must be publicized and open to the general public. First and second time Project Stream applicants are not required to match the requested amount; third time and thereafter applicants must show a 1:1 match of funds requested.

Deadlines for Project Stream requests is annually in June, with awards made in September.

Both Program Stream and Project Stream awards are based on scores determined by an Advisory Panel comprised of two individuals from each funded County.

The regional PPA program was implemented in 1997, resulting in the PCA achieving unprecedented expansion of state arts dollars to many new communities and a wide range of arts activities.

The Pennsylvania Council on the Arts is a state agency in the Office of the Governor. Created in 1966, the Council's mission is to foster the excellence, diversity, and vitality of the arts in Pennsylvania, and to broaden the availability and appreciation of those arts throughout the Commonwealth.

Of utmost importance is that the projects are strategic and outcome-based, as outlined in the criteria and guidelines for application. Awards are based on the recommendations of the Growth Fund Advisory Panel, and requests can be made for up to \$20,000.

Partners in this Fund initiative are the Pittsburgh Partnership for Neighborhood Development (PPND) and the Community Design Center of Pittsburgh (CDC). The partner team guides the program with outcome-based community planning.
